1) Spoof lecture- set up writing team.

2) SM/EG Ents things

2a Ball

EG: we have been thinking about the ball and if possible we would like to do the whole med school instead of splitting, therefore large venue needed. Have looked around Aston Court, we are thinking of doing meal tickets and ents tickets. SM: If people are buying meal and ents it would be £30 whereas with tickets, ents £12 wouldn't include transport.

SM: we would get sponsorship from MDU but only £100. FC: does that (Ashton court) include entertainment.

EG: that would include entertainment. EG: Meal ticket is coach there and back. SM: we decided against a buffet, as the meal at the last ball was cheap. **Vote** everyone think this is a good idea? All agree.

If people could work out their points and have everything clear before they make a request for funding.
